#### **Heart Foundation Heart Healthy Recipe**

#### **Nutty banana loaf**



**Preparation Time:** 15 mins **Cooking Time:** 45 minutes

Serves: 14

#### Ingredients

¼ cup olive oil

¼ cup maple syrup

3 eggs

3 medium bananas (30g), mashed

½ cup (50g) hazelnut meal

¼ cup (40g) wholemeal self-raising flour

1 tablespoon linseeds (flaxseeds)

¼ cup chopped unsalted pecans

¼ cup (40g) chopped unsalted cashews

¼ cup (40g) chopped unsalted almonds

¼ cup (70g) no added salt almond butter

14 raspberries, halved

#### Method

#### Step 1

Preheat oven to 180C.

Grease and line a 10cm x 20cm (base measurement) loaf pan with baking paper.

Whisk oil, syrup, eggs and bananas together in a large bowl.

Add hazelnut meal, flour, linseeds and half the combined nuts.

Stir to combine.

Pour mixture into the prepared pan. Smooth the surface and sprinkle with the remaining nuts.

#### Step 2

Bake for 40-45 minutes or until a skewer inserted in the centre comes out clean. Stand for 5 minutes before transferring to a wire rack to cool.

#### Step 3

Cut the loaf into pieces, spread with almond butter and serve with raspberries.
